Good to see the Society 'getting back to normal' with a successful Autumn production under our belt and the pantomime rehearsals off to a flying start.

Autumn Production

Well done to Alan for directing 'Pass the Butler' and the for cast and crew for a seamless production. We planned for a degree of audience hesitancy in being willing to come out to an indoor crowded event but audience numbers exceeded our expectations, excellent feedback was received from many.

Pantomime

It's back - oh yes it is! We are off to a flying start. The cast are enthusiastically tacking our latest pantomime, the Sleeping Beauty. Although only a few rehearsals in, we are off to a pleasing start.

We gave over the first rehearsal to a professional Voice Coach and all of us got something out of it. Each rehearsal now starts with a warm up session, putting into practice some of the techniques that we learnt. Each of these sessions is lead by a different cast member, in time all cast members will have a turn.

Although there has been news of the new 'omicron' Covid variant these past couple of days, there is nothing as yet to indicate that fresh restrictions will be in place by the time of the performances. We will off course be very mindful of official advice and will adapt if necessary.
