

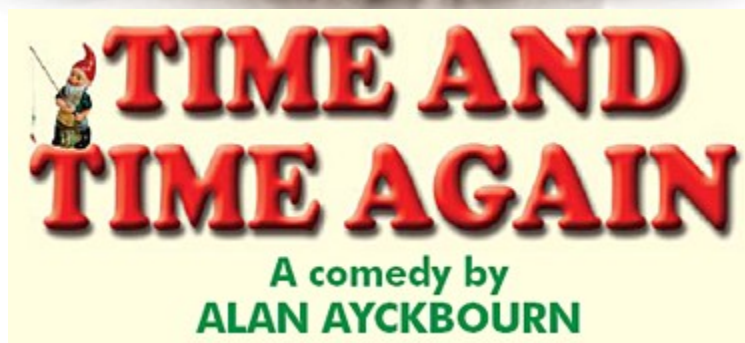
# Theatre & Dinner Trip
